Is your institution on track to comply with the new requirements of the **Violence Against Women Reauthorization Act (VAWA) regulations**? VAWA and the final rule are intended to require institutions to more effectively **address, and ultimately reduce, sexual violence on college campuses**, including sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking. The final regulations will become effective July 1, 2015.

The final rule details additional requirements to ensure that institutions **provide more complete information to their students**, better **inform and protect victims**, and **clarify the process** for collecting and reporting crime statistics in annual security reports. The rule also provides new requirements relating to the **complaint process**, addressing issues such as participation of attorneys, parties' access to the information that will be used in the decision-making process, and required content for notices of determination.
