Professor Painter will discuss the key parallels between government and business ethics, and the slippery slope to corruption.

Professor Painter is the S. Walter Richey Professor in Corporate Law at the University of Minnesota Law School. He has been active in numerous law reform efforts aimed at deterring various types of corporate fraud and improving ethics of corporate executives and lawyers. He is the author of several books, including *Getting the Government America Deserves: How Ethics Reform Can Make a Difference*.

Currently, Professor Painter is co-counsel in a lawsuit against President Trump alleging, among other things, that President Trump is in violation of the Emoluments Clause of the U.S. Constitution. Professor Painter has written many op-ed articles about this topic which have been appeared in *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post* and the *Los Angeles Times*.
