MINNEAPOLIS, Minn. The Civil Justice Reform Task Force will review and follow up on the findings of a report issued by the Civil Justice Forum, which was established in 2009 by then-Chief Justice Eric Magnuson. The forum examined civil case processing statutes, court rules, and practices to identify changes in the civil justice system that have the potential to increase cost-effectiveness and efficiency. The forum identified several initiatives, ranked them, and recommended a panel be created to more thoroughly study the possible impacts on litigants and civil case processing.
