MINNEAPOLIS (October 11, 2023) - Lathrop GPM Partner Julia Reiland was named a 2023 "Notable Women in Law" by *Twin Cities Business*. One of 25 honorees, the award recognizes the ability to guide clients through complex transactions, commitment to the community and advancing diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts through mentorship and pro bono work. This is the first time Reiland has received this honor.

The recognition includes only people who were nominated and accepted after editorial review. To qualify for this list, individuals must have at least five years of experience in their field and have shown the ability to effect change in their roles or areas of practice.

Drawing on this critical ground-level perspective, she advises health care organizations on complex business transactions and strategic partnerships, informed by her significant experience in joint ventures, affiliations, antitrust, governance, and contracting matters.
