Klein has handled numerous opposition and cancellation proceedings before the USPTO's Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (TTAB), including a successful opposition, last year, against an application to register BACH N ROLL MUSIC ACADEMY based on his client's mark BACH TO ROCK.

Klein regularly writes about current issues and presents on IP law topics nationally and internationally. He co-chaired PLI's annual seminar on Advanced Trademark Law for 14 years and has delivered numerous presentations and webinars for AIPLA, INTA, AIPPI and many other organizations.
